



Frequently Asked Questions: Last updated: 10/18/11

1. Will courses taken prior to the official start of the ETC program count toward the program certificate?

Yes, courses that are part of the ETC program, but were taken prior to the summer 2010 term, will count toward the ETC certificate. When making application to the program, simply include a note on previously taken courses to make sure our records are up to date.

2. Do any courses in the ETC program also count toward the MLC Master of Science in Education degree program?

The **EDU5104 Enhancing the Curriculum with Technology** course is also a course in the MLC masters degree in Education program. Currently, that is the only identical course between the two programs.

While **EDU9501 Teaching Online** and **EDU9502 Designing and Constructing Online Courses** are similar to **EDT5005 Teaching Online** and **EDT5006 Designing and Constructing Online Courses** in the graduate program, they are not identical. The graduate program courses require additional course work and students must meet higher standards.

Students may take the graduate courses **EDT5005** and **EDT5006** and have them count in both the graduate program and the ETC program. However, students may not take non-graduate level courses **EDT9501** and **EDT9502** have them count in the graduate program.

3. Has MLC given any thought to offering a master's degree program in Educational Technology?

As of 08/15/10, an additional emphasis has been added to the MLC Master of Education Degree program in the area of **Educational Technology!**
