Across five mornings of three class hours Greek Review will briskly examine the essentials of ancient Greek with particular attention to grammar. The course is intended to renew acquaintance with terminology and to refresh confidence with syntax. It will remind participants of the linguistic rationale for things the pastor-scholar "just knows" after long, practical use of ancient Greek away from a formal, academic setting. The format will combine lecture, illustration, and close study of selected portions of the New Testament.
