## IMPORTANT PLANNING NOTES

1. Courses & semesters may be shifted, **except** fifth year. Student teaching in the senior year will be determined by coursework still needed for the major; most likely you will student teach in the first semester due to Music electives needed in the second semester. STEP fifth year student teaching must be completed in Semester I as indicated on the program plan.
2. Courses shaded in gray are co-requisites and must be taken as a block.
3. Prerequisites for EDU4251 & EDU4350 Student Teaching are: PSY2002, EDU3210, PSY3020, EDU3215.
4. ♦EDU3405/Individual Field Experience hours are due the first Friday after spring break.
5. Regarding Early Field Experiences, make sure to register for each in the proper semester. If you do not register for them, you cannot receive credit for them.
6. Fitness for Life and First Aid are required general education activity courses for all students.
7. \*Regarding keyboard/piano or organ lessons, students beginning with MUS1001 and MUS1002/Keyboard for Classroom Teachers I & II take two additional semesters of private lessons. Students with keyboard background take three semesters of lessons and a semester of MUS3320/Music Technology.
8. \*If students test out of MUS3101, the sequence would be MUS3102, MUS3103 and either MUS4101 or MUS4102.
9. ✕ See Course Status and Five Year Plan on the Portal as not all Music courses are offered each year or each semester. You should plan out your STEP major courses for your entire program as you register for sophomore classes.
10. Required Choral/Vocal Music Major Courses are MUS2030, MUS2301, MUS3101, MUS3102/3, MUS3202, MUS3301, MUS3305, MUS4202, MUS4301, MUSxxxx (1 sem. of piano/organ voice), MUSxxxx (6 sem. choir), and MUSxxxx (3 cr. music elective).
