For him it is <i>not</i> an <i>area</i> elective, because it's <i>not classical</i>.</p> <p>The <i>kainhv</i> Greek student <i>must</i> take GRK3001.</p>	<p>Occasionally SPaM students <i>mistakenly</i> choose these no-column courses. At least two of the three sound logical to pastor training, but students get those two at WLS.</p>	<p>The courses in the no column sound logical to pastor training, but their content is covered at WLS.</p>	<p>The course in the No column sounds logical to pastor training, but their content is covered in SPaM courses and at WLS. (REL3001 and REL3002 are taken by public high school alums in place of REL0001 and REL0002.)</p>	<p>Occasionally SPaM students have had the <i>mistaken</i> impression that EDU3310 <i>Teaching a Foreign Language</i> is a SPaM free elective. It is <i>not</i>.</p> <p>SPN3001 may be taken as the Other Cultures elective.</p>
