The **DEADLINE** to apply for MLC need-based grants is **APRIL 15, 2021**. If applying for spring semester, the deadline is **NOVEMBER 1, 2021**. *Applications received after the deadline, without prior approval, will forfeit MLC need-based aid*.

Most types of financial aid including MLC institutional grants, distance grants, and certain loans are awarded on the basis of need.

US CITIZENS & ELIGIBLE NON-US CITIZENS

<u>must</u> submit a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) in order to be considered for needbased aid. The FAFSA must also be submitted by the deadlines noted above.

These deadlines do not apply to Federal Pell Grants / loans.

INTERNATIONAL / NON-US CITIZEN

STUDENTS should **NOT** submit a FAFSA. These students **must** complete the International Student Need Analysis Form (available through Net Partner or the Financial Aid Office) and this application.

NON-MLC GRANTS and SCHOLARSHIPS Students frequently receive grants and scholarships from outside agencies, businesses, or congregations. Contact our office if you receive any outside scholarships. By law, these funds must be considered as part of your financial aid package. We will then apply these outside scholarships to your billing statement, thereby reducing the amount you owe to MLC.

1. TUITION PAID FOR YOUNGER SIBLING

If your family paid **\$1500 or more** in private elementary or high school tuition for younger <u>sibling(s)</u> during the **calendar year 2020**, we will consider these payments. Only TUITION expenses actually paid between January 1, and December 31, 2020 will be included. *We cannot include fees, books, room, board, or other expenses*. Have the **school** complete the Special Circumstances Form and submit to the financial aid office.

2. MEDICAL EXPENSES

If your family had a high amount of medical or dental expenses that was NOT covered by insurance or a health savings account, we may be able to consider these payments. As a guideline, it takes at least \$5000 paid out-of-pocket in medical expenses to provide eligibility for additional financial aid. Complete the Special Circumstances Form and submit to the financial aid office.

3. LOSS OF INCOME/REDUCED INCOME

If your family experienced a loss or reduction of income, we may be able to consider this situation. Provide a written statement explaining the cause, approximate start date, and expected duration of the loss of income. Complete the Special Circumstances Form and submit to the financial aid office.
