Football Loses Shootout to Greenville

The football team has been led all season by its defense, but the offense carried the load in a 46-39 loss to Greenville Saturday.


Luke Rothe (*LPS*) accounted for five touchdowns, throwing four touchdown passes and running for another. **Scott Henrich** (*LPS*) caught nine passes for 132 yards and two touchdowns, while **Matt Olson** (*SCLHS*) added a rushing touchdown.

Defensively, the Knights had a difficult time with Greenville's no huddle attack. **Benjamin Olson** (*MVL*) finished with 25 tackles, the second most in school history in a single game. Four other MLC plays finished with at least 15 tackles in the game.

After a four-set loss to Northwestern Friday night, the volleyball team beat North Central Saturday to improve to 12-10 overall and 6-3 in conference play.

The Knights hung tough with Northwestern, but the Eagles proved too much Friday night. **Rebecca Engelbrecht** (*Shoreland*) had a big night to give MLC a chance, finishing with 19 kills and an attack percentage of .372. **Rachel Hein** (*LPS*) and **Heather Danell** (*MVL*) finished with nine and eight kills, respectively.

MLC had an easier time of things Saturday as it beat North Central in three sets. Danell led the way with 12 kills, while Engelbrecht finished with ten despite not playing for much of the third set. **Sara Willems** (*Lakeside*) added six kills, while **Jennifer Draeger** (*Lakeside*) led the back row defense with 18 digs.
